

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

PURPOSE SECONDARY SCHOOL

In conjunction with the Ministry of Education's Provincial Code of Conduct, Purpose Secondary has developed a Code of Conduct to ensure a Safe and Caring School.

- 1. RESPECT: A Purpose student respects each person regardless of race, religion, gender, age or sexual orientation. A Purpose student also respects personal and school property.**
- 2. NO DISCRIMINATION, VIOLENCE OR HARASSMENT: Each Purpose student helps to create a welcoming, caring school community that is free of any actions that make any individual unsafe or uncomfortable.**
- 3. DRUG AND ALCOHOL FREE ENVIRONMENT: A Purpose student recognizes the impact of drug and alcohol on their learning and the learning of others. A Purpose student does not come to school under the influence of drugs or alcohol.**
- 4. ATTENDANCE AND LATES: A Purpose student is expected to arrive on time and attend each day. When unable to attend or arrive on time, a Purpose student always communicates to the school, they will be late or absent and the reason.**
- 5. ELECTRONIC DEVICE USE: A Purpose Student uses their cell phone outside the classroom and main school area. A Purpose student listens to music to help them focus on their schoolwork with the permission of their classroom teacher.**
- 6. COMPUTER USE: A Purpose student uses a school computer for their coursework and education –related activities.**
- 7. DRESS CODE: A Purpose student dresses in a manner that is respectful of others.**
